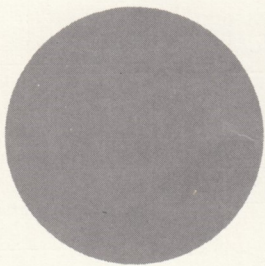
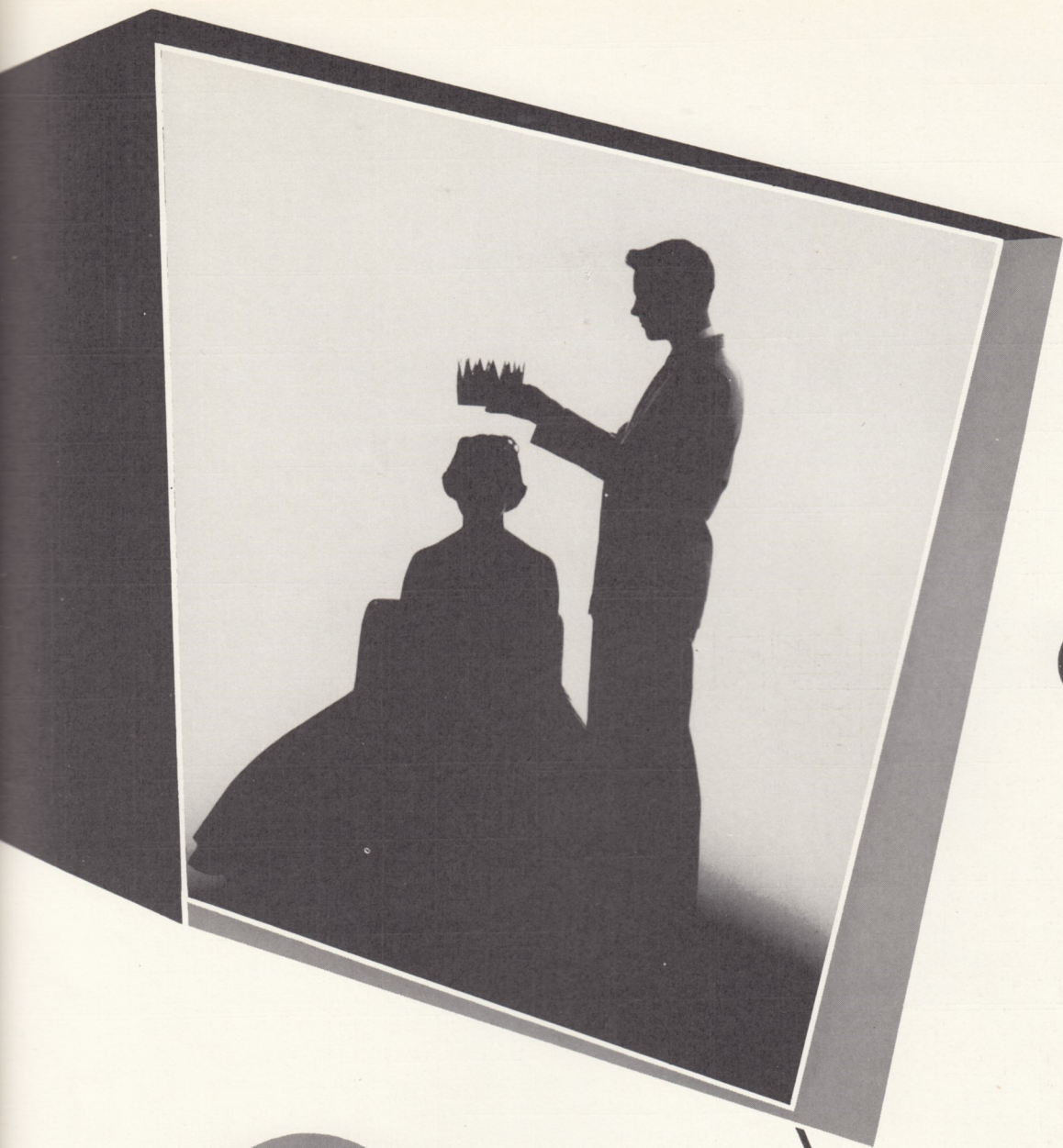


## *Foreword*

A flash of the camera and once more man had recorded an event on a roll of film; he had created an accurate and permanent record of the scene portrayed before him.

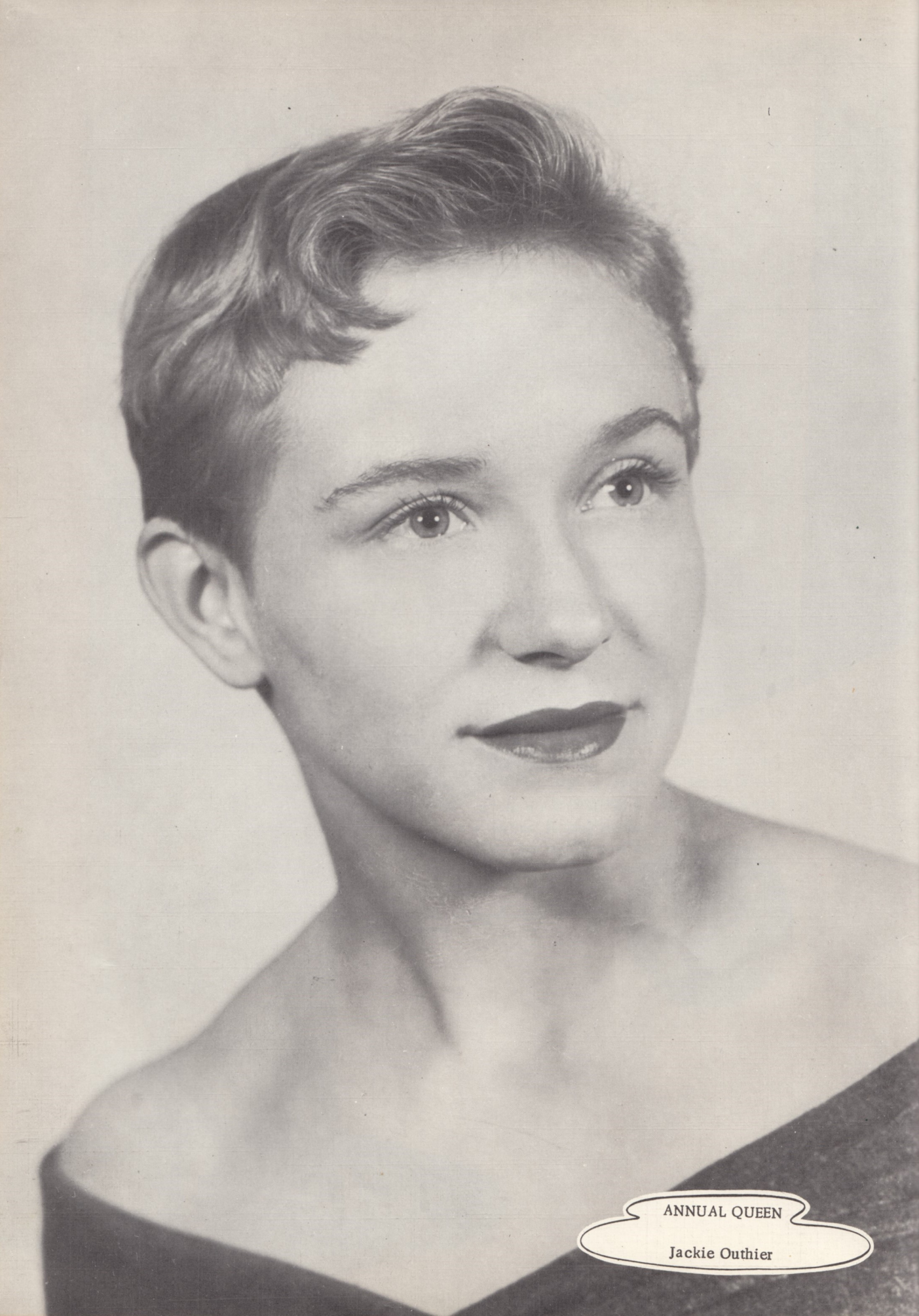
