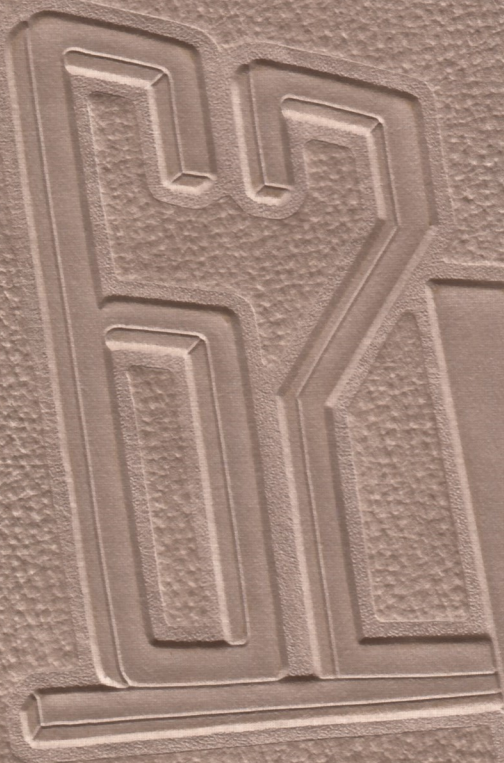

Superintendent's Message

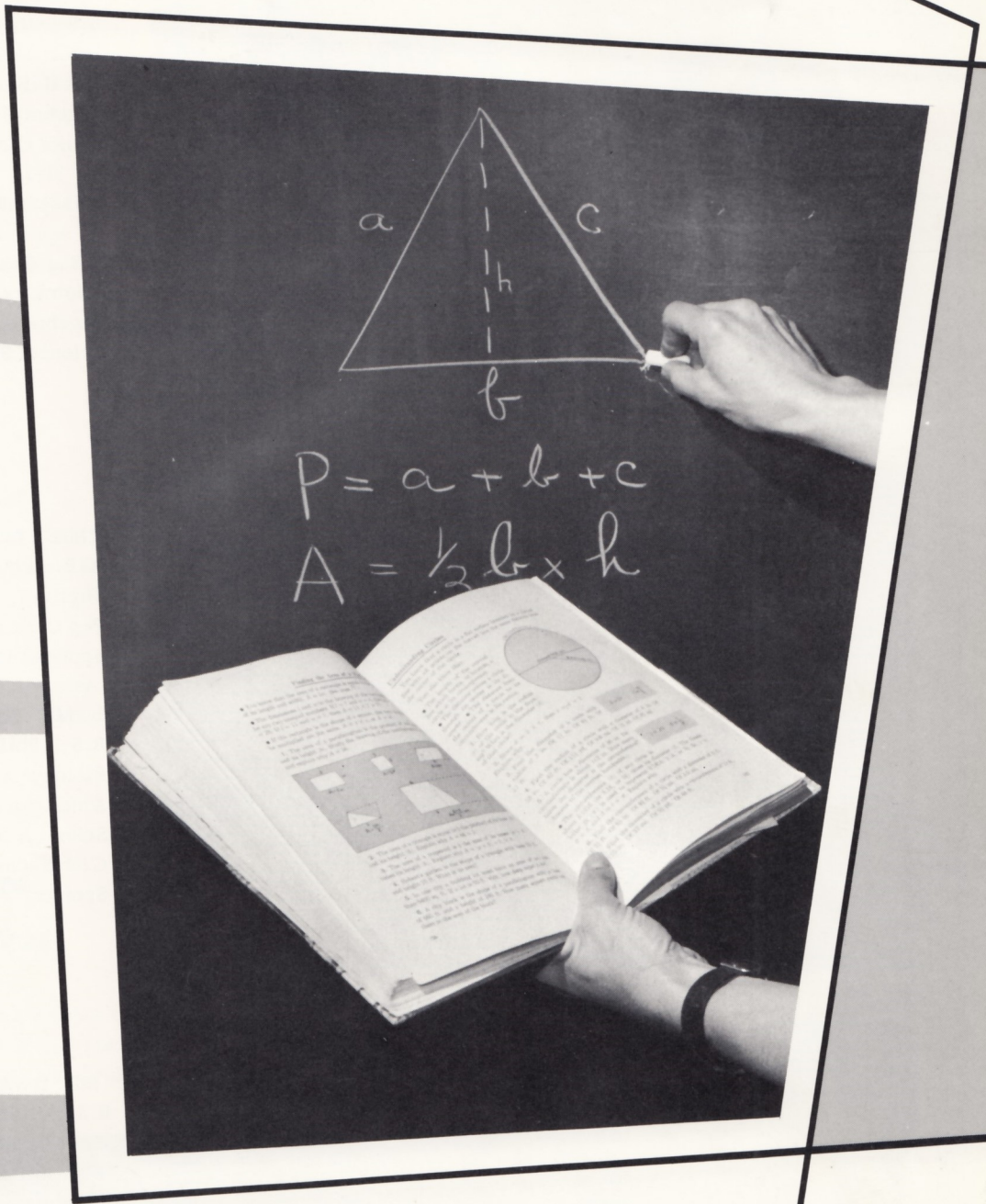
The young people are the greatest assets of any community, state, or nation. They are in the care of our schools more than half of their waking hours and these schools have a tremendous influence upon their lives.

During Basketball season, the girls' team had four wins and seventeen losses while the boys' team had six losses and fifteen victories.

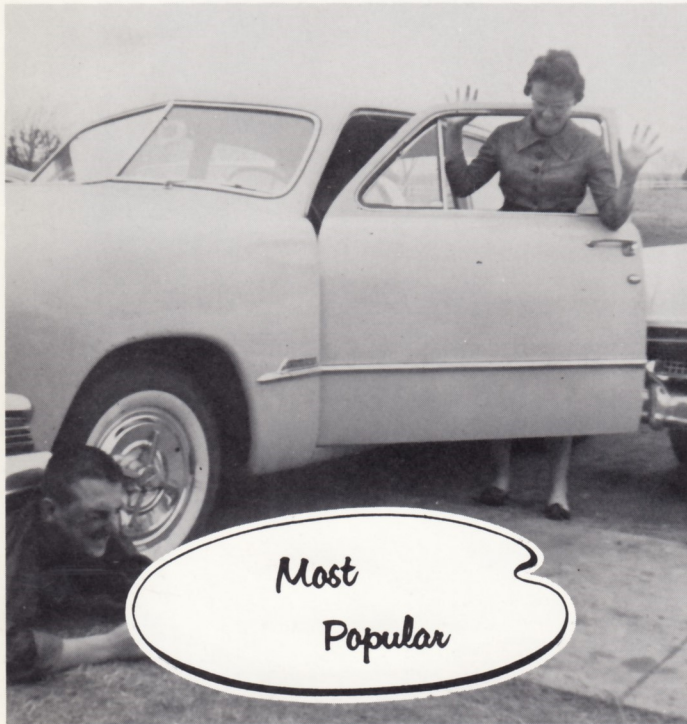

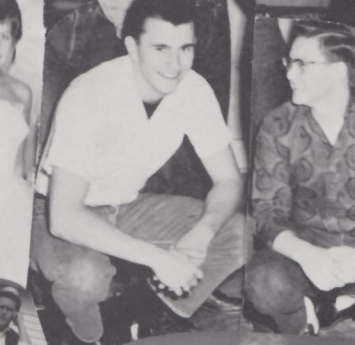
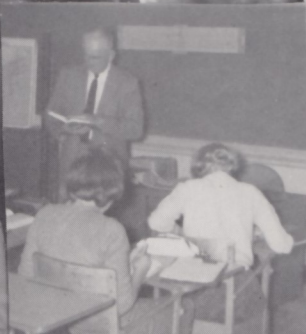
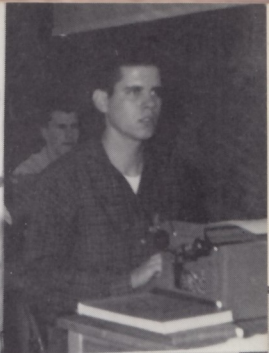


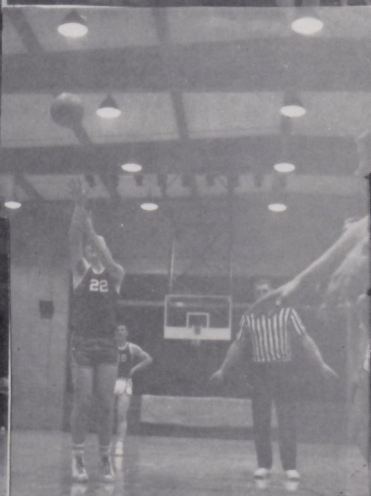
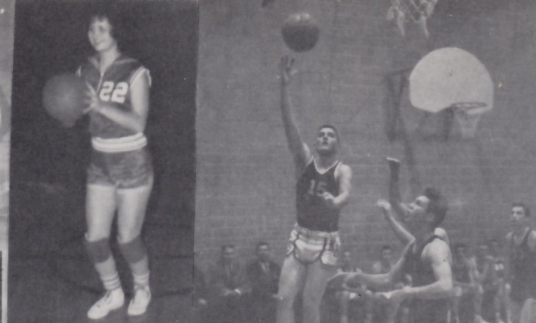
**SPEECH CLUB
