This 1963 BRONC is a simple pictorial record of the events at Kremlin High School during the 1962-63 school year.

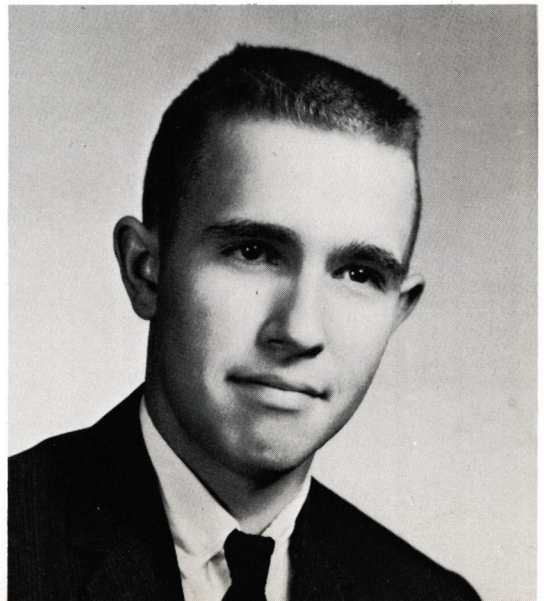

The Best All Around Students are two Juniors, Richard Christensen and Helen Weurflein. They were chosen by the faculty and also received the Masonic Award.



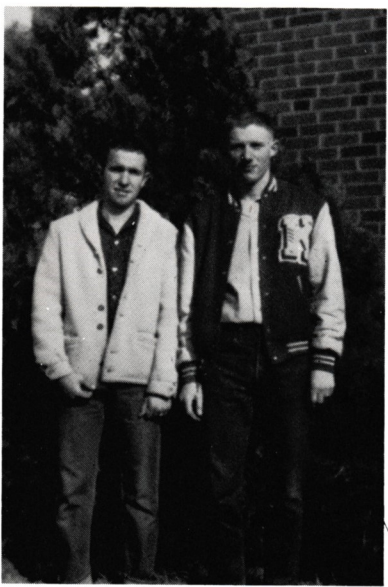
