

The 1967-1968 school year has slowly slipped into history, and we, the BRONC annual staff, hope this yearbook will serve as a pleasant reminder of all that happened.




To the underclassmen, we express a hope that this year's BRONC will show the beginning of a new time of progress. May the future be bright for the Kremlin Broncs.

Best All Around






