

## **Source documents for generating the maps of Garfield County One-Room Schools**

I obtained a full set of 1906 plat maps from the book by Geo. E. Ogle & Co., which showed school locations but did not give names or district numbers. The Garfield County Register of Deeds office was able to provide me with a document, source unknown, listing district numbers and names and post offices, but without specific locations for any of the schools. A collection of pages for each school from the Cherokee Strip Regional Heritage Center (CSRHC), the original preparer of those pages also unknown, included school district names and numbers along with specific legal descriptions for the locations. Finally, the 1901 plat maps, for which I purchased copies from CSRHC, showed not only school locations but also the school district numbers. Compiling and comparing all these sources allowed me to generate a new and complete set of maps and documentation. These original sources were difficult to track down, and came from separate sources, so I have prepared this document to preserve them and keep them together because of their historical value and interest and for any who want easy online access to them.

I thank Traci Harris in the Garfield County Register of Deeds office for providing me with the first useful list, which comes first in the following pages, and Aaron Preston from CSRHC for helping me with copies of the previous set of pages of information for each school, whose paper copies are still available at CSRHC.
